OVERVIEW

CHALLENGE

Perform a concentrated multi-trade rebuild inside an operating 4,690-square-foot suite while maintaining continuity of life safety, security, technology, and surrounding occupied conditions.

ASI APPROACH

ASI protected retained areas, rebuilt the core, created the server room and new offices, expanded the workstation area, and integrated ceilings, HVAC, plumbing, electrical, low voltage, fire protection, flooring, paint, and furniture.

RESULTS

- New server room and multiple room conversions inside the operating suite
- Expanded workstation area tied into power, data, ceilings, HVAC, and life safety
- Connectrac, concrete cutting, roof conduit, and final workplace installation coordinated through one contractor

The project concentrated major change into the suite core. ASI removed and rebuilt rooms, created critical technology space, expanded the workplace, and coordinated every architectural and building-system interface required to make the new plan operational.

The 4,690-square-foot suite plan establishes the full workplace context. The drawings identify a 987-square-foot construction area for the server room, office conversions and workstation changes, with connected trade interfaces.

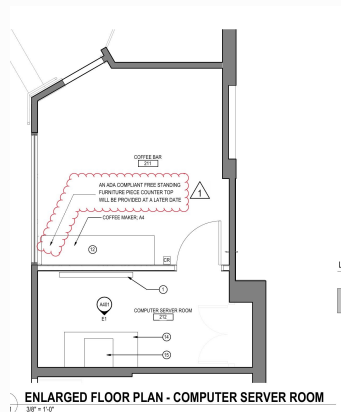

SURGICAL DEMOLITION. COMPLETE SYSTEM RECONNECTION.

The visible construction was only part of the work. Every room change had to reconnect ceilings, lighting, HVAC, fire protection, power, data, security, and finishes without losing control of the operating suite.



MAINTAIN THE OPERATING ENVIRONMENT

Separate the work zone, protect retained conditions, maintain required building and life-safety continuity, and control access and debris.



CREATE THE NEW PROGRAM

Build a new server room, convert meeting, copy, and storage rooms into offices, and open an enclosed office into a larger workstation area.



RECONNECT EVERY SYSTEM

Coordinate acoustical ceilings, lighting, HVAC, plumbing, required life-safety, electrical, low voltage, security, and technology interfaces.



SOLVE THE HARD INFRASTRUCTURE

Coordinate concrete cutting, Connectrac power and data, circuit modifications, a power monument, and rooftop conduit from the IT room to the antenna location.



DELIVER A FURNITURE-READY WORKPLACE

Complete flooring, paint, millwork, doors, hardware, appliances, furniture installation, cleaning, punch correction, and turnover.
